March Sermon Series - "Altar Ego"

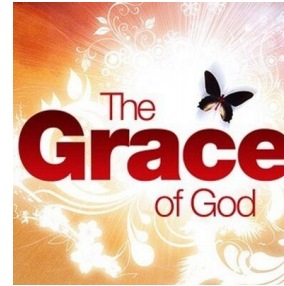
We are not our labels. We are not who others say we are.
